Tools and Methods for a Tutor

- 1. Find your group (4-5 people)
- 2. Brainstorm/Google/Look-up/Think about: Tools and Methods to help your Tutee improve his/her learning.
- 3. Find at least one tool for each sub-competence
 - Motivation and Self-esteem
 - Time Management
 - Organizing Information
 - Reflection on former learning experience
 - Group work
- 4. Visualize your results on a flipchart and present it to the group.
- 5. You have 30 minutes!





Role play

- 1. Go in groups (if possible) with your national colleagues (3 persons per group).
- 2. Take your test results from Monday.
- 3. You have 3 roles per group: Tutor, Tutee, Observer.
- 4. As Tutee take your tests results and discuss it with your Tutor.
- 5. As Tutor choose from all the methods and techniques, that you learned this week and apply it to help your Tutee.
- 6. As Observer, observe the Tutor!
 - Which technique does he/she use?
 - Does it work well? What works especially well?
 - Do you see points for improvement?
 - Give constructive feedback to the Tutor!
- 7. You have 15 minutes for the talk between Tutor and Tutee, 5 minutes for the Observer to give feedback.
- 8. Then change roles, so that everybody gets to be every role.
